Directions to Torres

What do to at The Airport in Porto Alegre

After you pick up your luggage walk to the airport lobby. If you are taking the GLEON bus to Torres, leave the lobby through the main door, cross the street and walk to the side of the main garage building where the GLEON bus is parked.

If you are taking the public bus to Torres you must purchase a ticket. While in the airport lobby go to the right and look for the sign "Passagens e Encomendas Intermunicipais-Posto Aeroporto";



If you wish to change some money this is the time to do it. There is a currency exchange window on your left.

After checking the Porto Alegre – Torres Public Bus Schedule (there's a link to it on the GLEON 10 web site), ask for your bus ticket to Torres (*Por favor, um bilhete para Torres, horário XXam/pm. Use your timetable and point the time you wish the ticket*).

Remember to allow at least half an hour if you are using a taxi or one hour if you are using public transportation to Central Bus Station.

Walk back and exit the airport building.



Now choose between taxi or public transportation to take you to the Central Bus Station (*Estação Rodoviária*).

Reaching Central Bus Station (Estação Rodoviária) By Taxi

As you leave the airport lounge you will see the taxi lane. They are red or white.

The fare is based on time of the day, before and after 22:00. The later you arrive more expensive it is.

Ask the driver to take you to the Central Bus Station (*Por favor, me leve à estação rodoviária*).

You will pay R\$30.00 (Brazilian Real) or ~\$17 (US) maximum.



Reaching Central Bus Station (Estação Rodoviária) By Bus

Just across the taxi lane you will find the bus stop.

Look at the signs for the 705 INDUSTRIAS bus.

Pay in cash (R\$ 2.30) either to the driver or collector.

This bus runs every 20 min, between 5:15am to midnight, from Monday to Saturday, and every 20 min, between 6:05am to 11:50pm on Sundays; City buses do not have special spaces for your luggage.

To warn the driver you want to get off the bus, use a small cord along the bus to ring a bell. Be careful, drivers break hard.

At the Central Bus Station (Estação Rodoviária)

Look at your ticket for the gate number (*box*).

As you walk in the Central Bus Station main corridor, look for signs indicating the gate number. They are on your left and right.



Walk in and check the bus parked at that specific gate. Different buses can use the same gate at different times. The sign on the bus front tells you the destination. Yours should read TORRES and possible stops if any.

Once you identify your bus, store your luggage in the cargo compartment. Keep your ticket at hand to be checked before your luggage is stored. You will be given a small claim ticket, keep it to recover your luggage in Torres.

Hand your bus ticket to the person at the bus door and wait for the stub.

Step in and pick your seat. There are overhead compartments for hand luggage.

In Torres take a taxi to the Guarita Park Hotel (*Por favor, me leve ao hotel Guarita Park*).
